### *MN Relocation Trust Fund*

There will be a 2020 Relocation Trust Fund collection this year. This fund was originated to assist homeowners in relocating their manufactured homes if the community were to close. When the MN Relocation Trust Fund drops below \$2 million, it prompts a trust fund collection of \$ 15.00 per homesite from all home owners living in a MH Community in the State of Minnesota.

#### **A \$ 15 fee will be billed to your rental account on September 1st.**

Residents that pay the \$15 participation fee by Oct 31st of this year are eligible to participate in the fund. Those that do not pay the fee by this deadline are ineligible. The fees collected are forwarded to the State of MN Relocation Trust Fund.

### *Boats & Campers*



Remember your boat or camper may only be at your homesite for up to 2 days ( 48 hours ) to allow for packing and unpacking of the vehicle. Storage of these vehicles must be done OUTSIDE of our community. They may NOT be stored in your yard or parking pad.
