




Winter Reminders

Winter Preparations

Make sure you do the following in preparation for the winter months that have now arrived.....

1. Plug in heat tape
2. Make sure your furnace filter has been replaced.
3. If necessary, have a furnace repair person look at furnace.
4. Make sure your skirting is tight so no critters can stay under your home in winter.
5. Plastic on inside of windows is not real good for home—the home needs to breathe but if you wish, make sure it is completed on the inside of the windows— not outside.
6. No blankets in windows. We never allow blankets or sheets. Please hang blinds or curtains on windows. hang.



Salt and Other De-Icers

- If you use rock salt or other common de-icers on your off street parking area or sidewalk, make sure to use the recommended amount. Adding more does not increase its effectiveness.
- Put down salt and de-icers as soon as a storm appears evident to prevent the ice from bonding to the pavement.
- Salt stops functioning under 15 degrees Fahrenheit. Sand can be used effectively in its place.
- Check out other grit at your local hardware stores as alternatives to the salt.

Reminder of Snowmobile Guidelines

If you are a snowmobile enthusiast, please remember that snowmobiles are only to be driven into and out of the community. We do not allow pleasure riding within our Paradise Park. Speed limit is always 10 MPH. Never drive on other resident's lawn or community areas. Be considerate of your Paradise Park neighbors. No storing of snowmobiles are allowed onsite or in the community.

Pumpkin Bread Pudding with Caramel Rum Sauce

2 eggs	1 1/2 cups Half and Half
1/4 cup sugar	1 tsp vanilla extract
3 tbsp heavy cream	3 tbsp dark rum
4 cups cubed pumpkin bread	
2/3 cup butterscotch caramel ice cream topping	

Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Prepare a 9 inch pie pan with cooking spray. Whisk together with eggs, Half and Half, sugar and vanilla in a bowl. Arrange the cubed pumpkin bread in the pie pan. Pour the egg mixture over the bread cubes. Bake 30-35 minutes or until a knife inserted into the center of the dish comes clean.

Combine the caramel sauce, heavy cream, and rum in a medium microwave for 45 seconds; whisk. Drizzle sauce over bread pudding to serve. Enjoy!
